Why is Ibercon no longer in central Madrid?

The new venue in Aranjuez offers much better conditions for the event. Part of the furry convention experience simply wasn't possible in central Madrid due to the limitations of the hotels in the area and other factors. After carefully considering all the feedback we received during Ibercon 2026, we've decided to move so we can address those concerns.

We've also established strong partnerships with both the hotel, whose team is genuinely excited to host the event and has gone above and beyond to support us, and the Aranjuez City Council. By working closely together, many of the challenges that seemed impossible to overcome this year have already been resolved. We have plenty of exciting announcements planned for Ibercon 2027... but that's all we'll say for now

Is the entire hotel reserved exclusively for Ibercon?

Yes. The Occidental Aranjuez has reserved all of its rooms and event spaces exclusively for Ibercon. This means that only Ibercon 2027 attendees will be able to stay at the hotel (more information on how to book a room will be shared later).

Having exclusive use of the entire hotel not only helps the Ibercon team avoid issues beyond our control, but also ensures that attendees can enjoy the convention in a safe, welcoming environment and make the most of the event.

Will these changes affect the ticket price?

No. Ticket prices for Ibercon 2027 will remain the same as they were in 2026.

We're also pleased to announce that accommodation at the main hotel will be considerably more affordable. Final room rates will be published over the coming months.

Will it be very hot now that the event has been moved to mid-June?

Let's be honest: it's hot in Spain at this time of year, which means wearing a fursuit outdoors during certain hours of the day isn't recommended.

That said, we've made this a top priority in our discussions with the hotel from day one, and we're taking every necessary step to ensure that everyone can stay comfortable indoors, even while wearing a fursuit, regardless of attendance numbers.

It's still too early to go into detail about the specific measures we'll be implementing, but we can already confirm that the entire hotel is fully air-conditioned and is experienced in hosting events involving hundreds of people engaged in physical activity at the same time. We take this very seriously.

Is it easy to get to Aranjuez?

Yes. Aranjuez is well connected by Cercanías commuter rail, bus services, and road. We'll publish a detailed travel guide with the best transportation options before the event.

Is there natural light?

Yes. All event rooms feature large windows with direct access to the terrace or pool area. This year, the only reason attendees will need to go to the basement is to visit the spa.

Can you share any other news?

These new dates mean that the swimming pool will be open for all attendees. In addition, having the entire hotel reserved exclusively for Ibercon allows us to host activities late into the night, attendees won't have to worry about disturbing other guests, and they will be able to return to their rooms whenever they like.
